If you are concerned about green space and ready to take action to preserve the natural corridors and habitats in the Miami Valley area a **special workshop will be held on Saturday, November 20, 2004, 9:00 a.m. - noon, at the Wegerzyn Gardens Metro Park, 1301 E. Siebenthaler, Dayton, OH.**

**The keynote presenter will be Elaine Marsh, Project Director, Ohio Greenways.** Elaine will focus on why greenways are important to communities and share examples of successful projects in other areas of Ohio. She is also president and cofounder of Friends of the Crooked River which advocates for the preservation and restoration of the Cuyahoga River.

This workshop is sponsored by Dayton's newest community environmental organization the Greenways of Greater Dayton. Members of the organization will share their vision and plans to stimulate the fulfillment of Arthur Morgan's vision of an "emerald necklace" around Dayton.

Three local land preservation organizations will share their accomplishments and plans at the workshop: the Three Valley Conservation Trust, the B-W Greenway, and the W-H Greenway.

Participants will learn how to get a local greenway organization started and will have the opportunity to make connections with others in the greenway community who have already preserved some emeralds in the "necklace".
